- Sec. 9. An individual is ineligible for election or reelection to any state elective office or local elective office of this state if any outstanding campaign statement, report, fee, late filing fee, or fine required to be filed or paid by that individual under state law has not been filed or paid.
- Resolved further, That the foregoing amendment shall be
 submitted to the people of the state at the next general election
 in the manner provided by law.
