

# HOUSE RESOLUTION NO.162

Reps. Glenn, Bollin, Crawford, Love, Schroeder, Wittenberg and Yaroch offered the following resolution:

1       A resolution to declare September 17-23, 2019, as Constitution  
2 Week in the state of Michigan.

3       Whereas, September 17, 2019, marks the two hundred and thirty-  
4 second anniversary of the drafting of the Constitution of the  
5 United States of America by the Constitutional Convention; and

6       Whereas, The 232nd anniversary of the signing of the  
7 Constitution provides an historic opportunity for citizens  
8 throughout Michigan and the nation to pay tribute to our Founding  
9 Fathers and to reflect on the rights, privileges, and  
10 responsibilities of citizenship; and

11       Whereas, By instilling faith in the promise of democracy, the



1 United States Constitution has served as a model for democratic  
2 governments around the globe; and

3       Whereas, The United States Constitution secured our commitment  
4 to freedom and democracy, a commitment which has guided us through  
5 more than two centuries of enormous growth and change; and

6       Whereas, We encourage all citizens to study the Constitution  
7 and reflect on the privilege of being an American with all the  
8 rights and responsibilities which that privilege involves; and

9       Whereas, The Constitution of the United States of America, the  
10 guardian of our liberties, embodies the principles of limited  
11 government in a Republic dedicated to rule by law; and

12       Whereas, Constitution Week is a time to emphasize citizens'  
13 responsibilities for protecting and defending the Constitution;  
14 now, therefore, be it

15       Resolved by the House of Representatives, That the members of  
16 this legislative body declare September 17-23, 2019, as  
17 Constitution Week in the state of Michigan.
