

# HOUSE RESOLUTION NO.166

Reps. Markkanen, Paquette, Bellino, Cambensy, Lasinski, Wozniak, Wendzel, Frederick, LaFave, Jones, Garza, Hood and Love offered the following resolution:

1       A resolution to declare September 23-27, 2019, as Clean Energy  
2 Week in the state of Michigan.

3       Whereas, Clean and readily abundant forms of energy are  
4 powering Michigan homes and businesses, and driving economic  
5 development and job growth more than ever before; and

6       Whereas, Clean energy generation from renewable sources such  
7 as wind, solar, hydro, and biomass sources comprise an important  
8 part of Michigan's present and future energy supply; and

9       Whereas, Michigan is among the top 15 states in the nation in  
10 wind-powered electricity generation, with over 2,000 MW of  
11 installed wind capacity, supporting over 2,000 direct wind industry



1 jobs and over two dozen manufacturing facilities in the state  
2 producing components for the wind industry; and

3       Whereas, Michigan is poised over the next decade to see  
4 exponential growth in solar energy deployment, with thousands of  
5 related jobs created and enhanced tax revenues for local government  
6 services and schools; and

7       Whereas, Michigan's aggressive investment in battery  
8 technology will pave the way for a transformation in both  
9 electricity generation and the transportation sector worldwide; and

10       Whereas, Michigan's entrepreneurs and businesses should be  
11 supported through good public policy and government collaboration  
12 to assert American energy leadership and ensure low-cost reliable  
13 energy at home; now, therefore, be it

14       Resolved by the House of Representatives, That the members of  
15 this legislative body declare September 23-27, 2019, as Clean  
16 Energy Week in the state of Michigan.
