Whereas, The state of Michigan is a leader in supporting 3 highway-rail grade crossing and pedestrian safety programs; and 4 5 Whereas, Highway-grade crossing crashes during 2018 resulted 6 in 1 person killed and another 15 persons injured in the state of 7 Michigan; and Whereas, Pedestrian/railroad trespass incidents on railroad 8 property during 2018 resulted in 6 persons killed and another 6 9 persons injured in the state of Michigan; and 10

2 Whereas, Collisions between trains and other motor vehicles or 3 pedestrians could have been prevented by increased public awareness of the appropriate safety laws and a greater understanding of the 4 5 dangers at crossings and around railroad property; and 6 Whereas, Operation Lifesaver is the foremost public 7 information and education program dedicated to preventing highway-8 rail grade crossing crashes and pedestrian/railroad trespass 9 incidents; and 10 Whereas, On September 22-28, 2019, and throughout the year, 11 all citizens are encouraged to observe added caution as motorists or pedestrians near tracks or trains; and 12 Whereas, This important observance should lead to greater 13 14 safety awareness and a reduction in highway-rail grade crossing 15 crashes and pedestrian/railroad incidents; now, therefore, be it

16 Resolved by the House of Representatives, That the members of this legislative body declare September 22-28, 2019, as Rail Safety 17 18 Week in the state of Michigan. We encourage all citizens to participate in activities to reduce crossing crashes and 19 20 pedestrian/railroad trespass incidents during the week and throughout the year. 21
