## HOUSE RESOLUTION NO.336

Reps. Stone, Clemente, Gay-Dagnogo, Hope, Cynthia Johnson, Kuppa, Sneller and Sowerby offered the following resolution: 1 A resolution to declare November 28, 2020, as Holodomor 2 Memorial Day in the state of Michigan. Whereas, Millions of Ukrainians perished as a result of the 3 Ukrainian Famine and Genocide (Holodomor) of 1932-33; and 4 Whereas, The term "Holodomor" is a Ukrainian word that means 5 6 "extermination by means of starvation"; and 7 Whereas, It is recognized that the Soviet authorities denied, concealed, or destroyed information about the Holodomor and that 8 accurate information about this tragic event has only recently been 9 made available; and 10 Whereas, The Organization for Security and Co-operation in 11 12 Europe (OSCE), the largest regional security organization in the

- 1 world, passed a resolution that welcomes the recognition of the
- 2 Holodomor in the United Nations, by the United Nations Educational,
- 3 Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO), and by the national
- 4 parliaments of a number of the OSCE participating states; and
- 5 Whereas, The OSCE strongly encourages all parliaments and
- 6 legislatures to adopt acts regarding recognition of the Holodomor;
- 7 and
- 8 Whereas, Some of the survivors of the Holodomor and their
- 9 descendants reside in Michigan and have contributed to Michigan's
- 10 cultural, economic, political, and educational life; and
- 11 Whereas, The people of Michigan value democratic freedoms,
- 12 human rights, and the rule of law, honor the values of compassion
- 13 and honesty, and cherish the multicultural vibrancy of the state;

- 15 Whereas, The 4th Saturday in November has been recognized
- 16 internationally as a day to commemorate the Holodomor; and
- 17 Whereas, The year 2020 marks the 87th anniversary of the
- 18 Holodomor; and
- 19 Whereas, It is important and fitting to observe Holodomor
- 20 Memorial Day for the purposes of recognizing the Holodomor and of
- 21 reflecting on the horrific legacy of this event; now, therefore, be

- 24 this legislative body declare November 28, 2020, as Holodomor
- 25 Memorial Day in the state of Michigan.
