- 1 A resolution to recognize April 24, 2019, as Suits and
- 2 Sneakers® Day.
- 3 Whereas, The Coaches vs. Cancer program is a nationwide
- 4 collaboration between the American Cancer Society and the National
- 5 Association of Basketball Coaches, leveraging the personal
- 6 experiences, community leadership, and professional excellence of
- 7 coaches nationwide to increase cancer awareness and promote healthy
- 8 living through year-round awareness efforts, fundraising
- 9 activities, and advocacy programs; and

- Whereas, The American Cancer Society saves lives and creates a 1 world with more birthdays by helping people stay well, get well, 2 3 find cures, and fight back in partnership with its nonpartisan advocacy affiliate, the American Cancer Society Cancer Action 4 5 Network; and 6 Whereas, More than 58,000 Michiganders will be newly-diagnosed 7 with cancer in 2019; and Whereas, Cancer patients face countless challenges associated 8 9 with their diagnoses, including physical, emotional, financial, and 10 day-to-day challenges; and 11 Whereas, Since 1993, coaches and their supporters have raised more than \$87 million for the American Cancer Society to help make 12 the American Cancer Society's services and programs available to 13 14 those who need them the most; and 15 Whereas, During January 21-27, 2019, the Coaches vs. Cancer Suits And Sneakers® Awareness nationwide effort united coaches 16 across the country to wear sneakers with their game attire while 17 18 coaching games. Similarly, it also encouraged lawmakers and others 19 to wear suits and sneakers to raise awareness about the fight 20 against cancer, share the importance of nutrition and physical 21 activity in reducing one's cancer risk, and promote the American 22 Cancer Society as a resource for help and support; and 23 Whereas, The Coaches vs. Cancer Suits And Sneakers® effort saw 24 Michigan coaches join together with their fellow coaches 25 nationwide, as well as thousands of volunteers for the American
- 26 Cancer Society and the American Cancer Society Cancer Action
  27 Network, to advocate on behalf of cancer patients, survivors, and
  28 caregivers so that one day cancer will be eliminated as a major
- 29 public health issue; now, therefore, be it

Resolved, That we urge all Michiganders to use this day as an opportunity to educate themselves about cancer and take proactive steps to reduce their risks and get appropriate screenings.
