## SENATE RESOLUTION NO.147

Senators Chang and Geiss offered the following resolution: 1 A resolution to congratulate the government and people of the 2 Republic of China (Taiwan) on the celebration of their 109th 3 National Day on October 10, 2020. 4 Whereas, Relations between the Republic of China (Taiwan) and the United States are marked by strong bilateral trade, education, 5 6 and cultural exchanges; and 7 Whereas, In 2018, Taiwan's bilateral trade totaled more than 8 \$76 billion in exchanged goods, making the United States the thirteenth-largest trading partner of Taiwan, and Taiwan the 9 fifteenth-largest trading partner of the United States; and 10 11 Whereas, Taiwan and the state of Michigan have long benefited 12 from this relationship. Taiwan has been Michigan's sixth-largest

- 1 market in Asia and Michigan exports to Taiwan have amounted to
- 2 \$298.59 million; and
- 3 Whereas, From 2013-2016, Michigan imports from Taiwan
- 4 increased from \$705 million to \$867 million, a 23 percent increase,
- 5 making the outlook for joint economic and cultural growth in the
- 6 future bright; and
- 7 Whereas, Taiwan is capable of and willing to fulfill its
- 8 responsibilities and collaborate with the world to deal with the
- 9 challenges of humanitarian aids and disease control; and
- 10 Whereas, Taiwan's meaningful participation in international
- 11 organizations benefits the international community as a whole,
- 12 including the state of Michigan; now, therefore, be it
- 13 Resolved by the Senate, That the members of this legislative
- 14 body congratulate the government and people of the Republic of
- 15 China (Taiwan) on their 109th National Day on October 10, 2020; and
- 16 be it further
- 17 Resolved, That we continue to support Taiwan's meaningful
- 18 participation in international organizations that impact the
- 19 health, safety, and well-being of its people, while also supporting
- 20 its aspiration to make more contributions in international
- 21 societies; and be it further
- 22 Resolved, That copies of this resolution be transmitted to the
- 23 United States Secretary of State, the Taipei Economic and Cultural
- 24 Office in Chicago, Illinois, and the members of the Michigan
- 25 congressional delegation.
