- 5 care centers, corporate and industrial settings, performing arts
- 6 centers, military branches, police and fire departments and
- 7 physician practices; and
- 8 Whereas, Leading organizations concerned with athletic
- 9 training and health care have joined together in a common desire to
- 10 raise public awareness of the importance of the athletic training
- 11 profession and to emphasize the importance of quality health care
- 12 within the aforementioned settings. Such an effort will promote the
- 13 athletic training profession and provide compassionate health care
- 14 for all; now, therefore, be it
