Whereas, We are in the 21st century, moving further into the 3 air age and a global economy, and airport infrastructure is 4 critical for our economy to compete in today's marketplace; and 5 6 Whereas, Michigan's geography as a peninsula makes aviation 7 necessary for the fast and efficient transport of people, goods, and services; and 8 Whereas, Nearly 1 billion pounds of air cargo are carried into 9 the state annually to support Michigan businesses. General aviation 10 11 contributes \$21.9 billion annually to our state economy; and 12 Whereas, Our businesses, industries, and foreign firms need reliable runways, taxiways, and navigational systems for the 13

- conducting of their business. Michigan boasts 234 public-use
  airports, serving over 13,550 pilots and 6,000 aircraft; and
  Whereas, More than 1,000 Michigan companies, employing 1
  million people, operate their own aircraft. Our state is home to 53
  charter flight companies, 97 repair stations, and 70 licensed
  flight schools; now, therefore, be it
