Rep. Whiteford offered the following resolution: 1 A resolution to declare May 2019 as Mental Health Awareness 2 Month in the state of Michigan. 3 Whereas, The month of May is designated as Mental Health Awareness Month by Mental Health America and its affiliates; and 4 Whereas, One in five adults in the United States have a mental 6 health condition and half of those have a co-occurring substance 7 use disorder; and 8 Whereas, Tens of thousands of Michigan residents live with 9 mental and behavioral health illnesses every year and many of them struggle to get the care they need; and 10 Whereas, In any given year, around 336,000 adults in Michigan 11 12 are documented as having a serious mental illness and 84,000 adolescents experience a major depressive episode with only 44% of 13

- 1 all individuals receiving some form of treatment; and
- 2 Whereas, Recognizing the need for reform, the House of
- 3 Representatives convened the bi-partisan House C.A.R.E.S.
- 4 (Community Access Resources and Safety) Task Force in 2017 to
- 5 discuss our state's mental health system; and
- 6 Whereas, The House C.A.R.E.S. Task Force Report was published
- 7 in January 2018 and contained several recommendations to better
- 8 connect the state's residents with access to care, treatment, and
- 9 prevention to improve their quality of life; and
- 10 Whereas, Of these many recommendations, the report looked at
- 11 addressing treatment and prevention in our jails and judicial
- 12 system, training for individuals to recognize a mental health
- 13 crises, expanding opportunities for individuals to be connected
- 14 with care, filling the shortage of mental health providers,
- 15 delivering care early to adolescents, and ensuring our veterans are
- 16 connected with services; and
- 17 Whereas, The Michigan House of Representatives will continue
- 18 to reduce the stigmatization of mental illness and work toward
- 19 providing quality services to those that are living with mental
- 20 health disorders and addictions; now, therefore, be it
- 21 Resolved by the House of Representatives, That the members of
- 22 this legislative body declare May 2019 as Mental Health Awareness
- 23 Month in the state of Michigan.
