Reps. Brixie, Coleman, Haadsma, Kuppa, Elder, Kennedy, Brenda Carter, Wittenberg, Hoadley, Witwer, Garza, LaGrand, Shannon, Garrett, Guerra, Camilleri, Stone, Koleszar, Pohutsky, Cherry, Gay-Dagnogo, Hertel and Warren offered the following resolution:

- A resolution to declare May 2019 as Asian Pacific American
  Heritage Month in the state of Michigan.
- 3 Whereas, The state of Michigan is fortunate to be home to more
- 4 than 300,000 residents of Asian and Pacific Island descent; and
- 5 Whereas, Asian Pacific Americans comprise one of the fastest
- 6 growing populations in both the state and the nation. In fact, the
- 7 largest growing population in Michigan, according to the 2010 U.S.
- 8 Census; and
- 9 Whereas, The Asian and Pacific Island regions are tremendously
- 10 diverse, with more than thirty countries, sixteen major ethnic

- 1 groups, nine languages, and numerous belief systems bringing their
- 2 culture to Michigan; and
- 3 Whereas, Citizens of Asian and Pacific Island descent, in each
- 4 generation, from the laborers who connected our coasts one-and-a-
- 5 half centuries ago, to the patriots who fought overseas while their
- 6 families were interned at home, these patriotic Americans have
- 7 enhanced our culture, quality of life, and economic vitality
- 8 through leadership, commitments to knowledge and advancement, and
- 9 dedication to their communities; and
- 10 Whereas, The state of Michigan and the United States of
- 11 America have been enriched by the contributions of Asian Pacific
- 12 Americans in all facets of life, including the arts, sciences,
- 13 business, education, and philanthropy. Michigan has recognized the
- 14 contribution Asian Pacific Americans and other immigrants make to
- 15 our economy with the establishment of the Michigan Office for New
- 16 Americans; and
- 17 Whereas, The culture and contributions of our Asian and
- 18 Pacific Island residents will continue to grow in significance as
- 19 more Asian Pacific Americans choose to make Michigan their home and
- 20 as our economy becomes increasingly intertwined with the economies
- 21 throughout Asia; and
- 22 Whereas, Asian Pacific Americans, through advocating issues of
- 23 justice and equality, continue to break down the barriers of
- 24 discrimination, indifference, and intolerance, thereby opening
- 25 doors for all Asian Pacific Americans; and
- 26 Whereas, Asian Pacific American residents are proudly served
- 27 in Michigan by many dedicated organizations, including the Michigan
- 28 Asian Pacific American Affairs Commission, the Asian Pacific
- 29 American Chamber of Commerce, the Council of Asian Pacific

- 1 Americans, Asian American Citizens for Justice, Asian Center
- 2 Southeast Michigan and the West Michigan Asian Pacific American
- 3 Association, APIA Vote Michigan and the Michigan Asian Pacific
- 4 American Bar Association; and
- 5 Whereas, The state of Michigan takes pride in its cultural
- 6 diversity and welcomes the opportunity to honor our Asian Pacific
- 7 American residents for their lasting, expanding, imprint upon our
- 8 state; now, therefore, be it
- 9 Resolved by the House of Representatives, That the members of
- 10 this legislative body declare May 2019 as Asian Pacific American
- 11 Heritage Month in the state of Michigan. We encourage all citizens
- 12 to celebrate the individual and collective contributions of Asian
- 13 Pacific Americans to this state and to this country.
