- 5 Whereas, It is appropriate that we honor the correctional
- 6 officers in all our institutions, at all levels of government, for
- 7 their invaluable contributions to our society; and
- 8 Whereas, Correctional facilities require staffing throughout
- 9 each hour of the year, which leads to overtime and sacrifices made,
- 10 not just by the correctional officers, but by their family members
- 11 who should also be commended for the time they forfeit for the sake
- 12 of public safety; and
- 13 Whereas, Both state and national observances of this week will
- 14 focus on increasing public awareness and the important
- 15 contributions of correctional officers nationwide; now, therefore,
