HOUSE RESOLUTION NO.138

Reps. Cambensy, Sowerby, Chirkun, Howell, Gay-Dagnogo and Clemente offered the following resolution:

1 A resolution to declare June 22, 2019, as Michigan Mountain 2 Biking Day in the state of Michigan.

3 Whereas, World-class biking experiences can be found in the

4 over 1,300 miles of mountain biking trails scattered throughout the

5 state of Michigan-from the tip of the Keweenaw Peninsula to metro

6 Detroit; and

7 Whereas, Michigan is home to a variety of trail challenges

8 including expert-level tracks with edgy bedrock and roots to smooth

9 flowing switchbacks. The diversity of Michigan's single-track

10 brings together every type of biker from beginners to world

11 champion racers. Michigan's diverse trails allow every cyclist to

12 find a trail that best suits their interests and comfort level; and

- 1 Whereas, Michigan proudly is home to two International
- 2 Mountain Bicycling Association Ride Centers, Copper Harbor and
- 3 Marquette. Only 40 of these mountain bike towns exist in the world.
- 4 The Copper Harbor and Marquette Ride Centers have been
- 5 internationally recognized for their exemplary design and
- 6 incredible rider experience. Additionally, the Copper Harbor trails
- 7 have been rated among the best in the country by National
- 8 Geographic and the Marquette trail system has been nationally
- 9 recognized by USA Today; and
- 10 Whereas, Michigan is also home to an International Mountain
- 11 Bicycling Association Epic trail, the High Country Pathway in the
- 12 Pigeon River Country State Forest near Vanderbilt. Only 42 IMBA
- 13 Epic trails exist in the United States. This 70-mile trail is known
- 14 for its backcountry adventure and elk viewing experiences; and
- 15 Whereas, The state's mountain biking trails connect thousands
- 16 of residents and visitors to the local economy. According to the
- 17 Outdoor Industry Foundation, nearly 45 million Americans mountain
- 18 bike each year. In Copper Harbor alone, their trails bring in more
- 19 than 20,000 bikers annually. The mountain biking tourism industry
- 20 provides a healthy boost to the Michigan communities who maintain
- 21 our renowned trails; and
- Whereas, Michigan mountain biking trails provide healthy, fun
- 23 activities for all ages and connect bikers to the natural wonders
- 24 of Michigan's environment. Mountain biking trails in the state
- 25 provide unique opportunities for riders to experience up-close all
- 26 that our wilderness and lakes have to offer; now, therefore, be it
- 27 Resolved by the House of Representatives, That the members of
- 28 this legislative body declare June 22, 2019, as Michigan Mountain
- 29 Biking Day in the state of Michigan.
