Glenn offered the following resolution: 1 A resolution to commemorate August 26, 2019, as the 99th 2 anniversary of the adoption of the Nineteenth Amendment by the 3 Congress of the United States. 4 Whereas, Congress proposed the Nineteenth Amendment on June 4, 5 1919; and Whereas, On June 10, 1919, the first three states ratified the 6 7 Nineteenth Amendment, including Michigan; and 8 Whereas, Over a year later on August 18, 1920, Tennessee became the thirty-sixth state to ratify the Nineteenth Amendment; 9 10 and Whereas, On August 26, 1920, U.S. Secretary of State 11

Bainbridge Colby certified the Nineteenth Amendment, and women

- 1 finally achieved the long-sought right to vote in the United
- 2 States; and
- Whereas, On November 2, 1920, millions of women across the
- 4 United States voted in elections for the first time; and
- 5 Whereas, Each year to follow, more women have been
- 6 participating in elections and public service, including the
- 7 record-high 53 women currently serving in the Michigan House of
- 8 Representatives; and
- 9 Whereas, This would have not have been possible without the
- 10 decades of hard work and sacrifices made by those who contributed
- 11 to making the Nineteenth Amendment a reality; and
- 12 Whereas, We recognize and honor those individuals who changed
- 13 the course of our history and opened so many doors for women in
- 14 America; now, therefore, be it
- 15 Resolved by the House of Representatives, That the members of
- 16 this legislative body commemorate August 26, 2019, as the 99th
- 17 anniversary of the adoption of the Nineteenth Amendment by the
- 18 Congress of the United States.
