## HOUSE RESOLUTION NO.154

Reps. Steven Johnson, Markkanen, LaFave and LaGrand offered the following resolution:

A resolution to encourage the National Park Service to establish a moose tag lottery hunt to assist in controlling the moose population on Isle Royale.

Whereas, Isle Royale National Park in Michigan is home to an 4 5 exploding population of moose. The Michigan Technological

University Wolf Study 2018-2019 Annual Report estimates moose have 6

7 increased sharply from a population of 515 in 2011 to a current

moose population of 2,060, an average growth rate greater than 19 8

percent annually; and 9

Whereas, Issues with the moose-to-wolf ratio over the last several decades have now reached a tipping point, with a current 12 population of only 15 wolves on Isle Royale as of March 2019.

- 1 Wolves are the only natural predator of moose on Isle Royale but
- 2 the diminishing wolf population has not contained the moose
- 3 population in recent years; and
- 4 Whereas, The increased and unsustainable moose population on
- 5 Isle Royale has created an ongoing ecological dilemma as the moose
- 6 feed on the park's balsam fir trees and other vegetation. The
- 7 rapidly expanding moose herd will devastate these slow-growing
- 8 trees and could eliminate them from Isle Royale; and
- 9 Whereas, Previous attempts to introduce additional wolves to
- 10 balance out the moose-to-wolf ratio have not resulted in a long-
- 11 term sustainable balance of predator and prey; and
- 12 Whereas, A moose tag lottery hunt will benefit Isle Royale
- 13 National Park and help restore ecological balance among moose,
- 14 wolves, and vegetation. Approximately forty national parks
- 15 currently allow some form of hunting as part of their wildlife
- 16 management practices; and
- 17 Whereas, This hunt will provide a unique hunting experience
- 18 for a number of hunters each year, which in turn will bring
- 19 increased economic activity to the western Upper Peninsula; now,
- 20 therefore, be it
- 21 Resolved by the House of Representatives, That we encourage
- 22 the National Park Service to establish a moose tag lottery hunt to
- 23 assist in controlling the moose population on Isle Royale; and be
- 24 it further
- 25 Resolved, That copies of this resolution be transmitted to the
- 26 Director of the National Park Service, the members of the Michigan
- 27 congressional delegation, the Director of the Michigan Department
- 28 of Natural Resources, and the Governor of Michigan.
