- 8 of exposure to environmental hazards. In 2018, Michigan ranked 33rd
- 9 in well-being of children and 25th in overall children's health
- 10 according to the Annie E. Casey Foundation; and
- 11 Whereas, Every child deserves a chance to learn, grow, and
- 12 succeed. Our children are the future of this state. Their success
- 13 is our success and it is important to ensure clean air and water
- 14 for our children; and
- 15 Whereas, The goal of Children's Environmental Health Day is to
- 16 raise awareness about clean air and water, safe food and consumer
- 17 practices, and healthy environments for children's health and
- 18 development; and
- 19 Whereas, Children's Environmental Health Day is generally
- 20 observed on the second Thursday in October. This day celebrates the
- 21 progress of the children's environmental health movement and aims
- 22 to showcase a strong network of child health advocates; and
