LaFave offered the following resolution: 1 A resolution to commemorate the 30th anniversary of the 2 signing of the Americans with Disabilities Act. 3 Whereas, Approximately 57 million Americans have a disability; 4 and Whereas, July 26, 2020, is the 30th anniversary of the signing of the Americans with Disabilities Act by President George H.W. 6 7 Bush; and Whereas, The Americans with Disabilities Act is the most 8 9 comprehensive civil rights law in history for people with disabilities; and 10 Whereas, The Americans with Disabilities Act reaffirmed the 11 12 ideas that all people are entitled to participate fully in our 13 economy and democracy, have something to contribute, and deserve

every chance to achieve their full potential; and 1 2 3 Whereas, The Americans with Disabilities Act promises fairness, accommodation, and participation in all aspects of 4 5 American life; and 6 Whereas, Every individual deserves respect, access, and equal 7 opportunity; and 8 Whereas, The state of Michigan is enriched by the diversity 9 and accomplishments of Americans with disabilities; and 10 Whereas, The unemployment rate for people with disabilities is 11 still far higher than that of people without disabilities; and Whereas, We recognize that our work to uphold the spirit and 12 the letter of this law is not yet finished; now, therefore, be it 13 14 Resolved by the House of Representatives, That the members of 15 this legislative body commemorate the 30th anniversary of the signing of the Americans with Disabilities Act. We salute everyone 16 17 whose efforts contributed to the enactment of the Americans with Disabilities Act and commit compliance with and furthering its 18 19 principles. We urge all Michiganders to acknowledge and celebrate
