HOUSE RESOLUTION NO.317

Reps. Griffin, Alexander, Whiteford, Lightner, Hall, Allor, LaFave and Wozniak offered the following resolution:

1 A resolution to declare October 15, 2020, as Pregnancy and 2 Infant Loss Remembrance Day in the state of Michigan.

3 Whereas, Each year, approximately one million pregnancies in

4 the United States end in miscarriage, stillbirth, or the death of a

5 newborn baby. It is a great tragedy to lose the life of a child.

6 Babies sometimes live within or outside their mothers' wombs for

7 only a short period of time. Even the shortest lives are still

 $oldsymbol{8}$ valuable and the grief of those who mourn the loss of these lives

9 should not be trivialized; and

10 Whereas, The observance of Pregnancy and Infant Loss

11 Remembrance Day may provide validation to those who have lost a



- baby through miscarriage, stillbirth, or infant death; and 1 Whereas, A public that is informed and educated about 2 miscarriage, stillbirth, and infant loss can better learn how to 3 respond with compassion to affected families. Professionals who 4 5 come in contact with families who have suffered such losses, such 6 as physicians, clergy, emergency medical technicians, funeral 7 directors, police officers, public health nurses, educators, and 8 employers, can better serve families if they have better knowledge 9 of pregnancy and infant loss; and 10 Whereas, Recognizing Pregnancy and Infant Loss Remembrance Day 11 will provide the people of the state of Michigan with an opportunity to increase their understanding of the great tragedy 12 involved in the deaths of unborn and newborn babies; and 13 14 Whereas, Pregnancy and Infant Loss Remembrance Day will 15 enable the people of Michigan to consider how, as individuals and communities, they can meet the needs of bereaved mothers, fathers, 16 and family members, and work to prevent the causes of these deaths, 17 18 now, therefore, be it Resolved by the House of Representatives, That the members of 19 20 this legislative body declare October 15, 2020, as Pregnancy and 21 Infant Loss Remembrance Day in the state of Michigan. We support 22 the goals and ideals of National Pregnancy and Infant Loss 23 Remembrance Day; and be it further Resolved, That we recognize the grief of the families who have 24 25 experienced miscarriage, stillbirth, or infant loss and wish to
- 26 help heal and comfort these families in a time of pain and
 27 heartache, to give the families hope for the future, and to assist
 28 women and families across the state in understanding their
 29 experience.
