

HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 362

The Speaker, on behalf of the entire membership of the House of Representatives, offered the following resolution:

1 A resolution of tribute for the Honorable Michael Webber.

2 Whereas, It is with great appreciation for his commitment to
3 the people of the state, especially his constituents in the Forty-
4 fifth District, that we honor Representative Michael Webber for his
5 service to the Michigan House of Representatives; and

6 Whereas, Representative Webber earned a bachelor's degree in
7 international relations from Michigan State University's James
8 Madison College. Before being elected to this chamber, he worked as
9 a licensed insurance agent and served more than nine years in state
10 government, including on the staff of former Governor John Engler.
11 Representative Webber also served seven years on the Rochester
12 Hills City Council, including three years as vice president; and

1 Whereas, Representative Webber was first elected to the House
2 of Representatives in 2014. During his six years of service,
3 Representative Webber was a leader on many important issues. He
4 served as the chair of the Regulatory Reform Committee and the vice
5 chair of the Criminal Justice, Government Operations, and
6 Transportation and Infrastructure committees. He was also an active
7 member of the Energy Policy, Insurance, Oversight, Tax Policy, and
8 Elections and Ethics committees. Among his many accomplishments,
9 Representative Webber sponsored legislation that was enacted to
10 provide sales tax fairness between retail and online sellers and to
11 legalize sports gambling in Michigan; now, therefore, be it

12 Resolved by the House of Representatives, That we offer this
13 expression of tribute to commend and thank the Honorable Michael
14 Webber for his notable contributions to this legislative body and
15 to our state; and be it further

17 Representative Webber as evidence of our gratitude and best wishes.
