FY 2020-21 Supplemental Appropriation Items

1. Authorization of Emergency Assistance for Non-Public Schools (EANS) Program (Sec. 11o) – NEW

Authorizes \$86.8 million federal Governor's Emergency Education Relief (GEER) Fund for the EANS Program as designated under the Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations (CRRSA) Act. The program provides services and assistance to nonpublic schools through a grant application process administered by the Michigan Department of Education (MDE).

2. Summer Programming (Sec. 23d) – NEW

Provides \$10.0 million federal GEER Fund for parents or legal guardians whose child(ren) are enrolled in summer programming in 2021. Summer programming may include programs under Sec. 23b or other educational enrichment programs. An eligible parent or guardian receives \$50 per enrolled child plus reimbursement for expenses incurred, not to exceed an additional \$200 per child. Payments may be prorated if funds are insufficient.

Increases school lunch funding by \$656,000 School Aid Fund (SAF) for a total of \$23.8 million SAF.
