SUMMARY:

Senate Bill 537 would amend the Management and Budget Act to change a provision that, beginning with July 1, 2021, requires the legislature to pass and present to the governor general appropriation bills for the upcoming fiscal year by July 1.

The bill would amend the provision to remove the word “general.” Under the bill, beginning with July 1, 2021, the legislature would have to pass and present to the governor one or more appropriation bills for the upcoming fiscal year by July 1.

The upcoming fiscal year, for purposes of the July 1, 2021, deadline, is the 2021-22 fiscal year.

The bill would have no fiscal impact on the state or local units of government.
