SUMMARY:

House Bill 4041 would amend the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act to require the Department of Natural Resources (DNR) to give priority to Michigan residents for reservations at a state park or state forest before making those reservations available to nonresidents. This would apply to reservations at a campground, cabin, yurt, or lodge in a state park or a state forest. Under the bill, the DNR would have to make openings available to residents for at least two weeks before the openings were made available to nonresidents.

House Bill 4041 would not affect costs or revenues for the DNR or local units of government
