## **SUMMARY:**

House Bill 4332 would amend Part 811 (Off-Road Recreation Vehicles) of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act to allow the license for a two-wheel off-road vehicle (ORV) to be placed either centered on the exposed surface of the rear fender or located at a visible place on a front suspension fork.

Currently under the act and Department of Natural Resources rules, an ORV license for a two-wheel vehicle must be centered on the exposed surface of the rear fender. (Below is an image provided by Offroad Ed indicating the current license placement requirement.)

The bill would also allow the license to be located at a visible place on a front suspension fork.

Two-wheel vehicle: center the ORV sticker on the exposed rear fender.



## **FISCAL IMPACT:**

House Bill 4332 is unlikely to affect costs or revenues for the Department of Natural Resources or local units of government.
