SUMMARY:

House Bill 4604 would amend the Michigan Memorial Highway Act to designate the portion of highway I-75 between 12 Mile Road and 14 Mile Road in the city of Madison Heights in Oakland County as the “Captain Jeffrey Brozich Memorial Highway.”

The act currently designates I-75 in Wayne and Oakland Counties as the “Walter P. Chrysler Freeway.” The bill would exclude from this designation the portion of I-75 that it would name in honor of Captain Jeffrey Brozich, as described above.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Section 2 of the Michigan Memorial Highway Act indicates that the State Transportation Department shall only provide for the erection of suitable markers indicating the name of the highway “when sufficient private contributions are received to completely cover the cost of erecting and maintaining those markers.” As a result, the bill has no state or local fiscal impact.
