SUMMARY:

House Bill 4921 would amend the Medical Marihuana Facilities Licensing Act to revise when a licensee is required to transmit financial statements of the licensee's total operations to the Marijuana Regulatory Agency and the municipality. Currently, the statements must be submitted no later than 30 days after the end of each state fiscal year. The bill would eliminate that submission time period and simply require the financial statements to be submitted each year. This would apply to a person holding a state operating license under the act as a grower, processor, secure transporter, provisioning center, or a safety compliance facility.
