SUMMARY:

House Bill 5286 would amend the Michigan Vehicle Code to provide that if a work zone has a speed limit that is enforced only when workers are present, both of the following apply to the requisite speed limit sign for the work zone:

- It must have flashing lights that are activated when workers are present.
- It may have a digital speed limit display that shows the speed limit being enforced while the display is activated.
