SUMMARY:

House Bill 5634 would amend the Michigan Penal Code to allow a person to carry concealed a fishing knife that is adapted and carried as a fishing knife. A person is currently allowed to carry concealed a hunting knife that is adapted and carried as a hunting knife, but is prohibited from carrying certain other knives concealed, such as a dagger, dirk, or stiletto.
