SUMMARY:

House Bill 5871 would amend the Medical Marihuana Facilities Licensing Act (MMFLA) to expand the types of entities from or to which a licensed processor or licensed provisioning center is authorized to buy, sell, or transfer marijuana or marijuana-infused products. The table below shows (in *italics*) the changes proposed by the bill.
