FY 2021-22 Supplemental Appropriation Items

1. Oxford Response (Sec. 11w) – NEW

Provides \$6.8 million SAF to a district forced to close a building for at least 20 consecutive days in response to an act of student violence (Oxford Community Schools) as follows: \$3.5 million over two fiscal years for a psychologist, family school liaison, mental health director, school resource officer, safety and security assessments, public relations consulting, private security, summer school, insurance copays, and legal services; \$2.3 million for one-time costs, including physical repairs, a third-party review, a mass notification system, and security cameras; and \$1.0 million with no specified requirements.
