FY 2021-22 Supplemental Appropriation Items

1. Oxford Response (Sec. 11w) – NEW

Provides \$9.8 million SAF to a district forced to close a building for at least 20 consecutive days in response to an act of student violence (Oxford Community Schools) for personnel and additional student supports, including psychologists, family liaisons, mental health staff, school security, additional learning time, legal fees, and the physical restoration of a school building. 2. Risk Assessments (Sec. 97c) – NEW

Provides \$15.0 million Gross (\$3.8 million GF/GP) for grants to districts, ISDs, and nonpublic schools in an amount not to exceed \$2,000 per school to implement risk assessments.

3. Critical Incidence Mapping (Sec. 97d) – NEW

Provides \$12.5 million Gross (\$2.5 million GF/GP) for districts, ISDs, and nonpublic schools to implement critical incidence mapping of each school.
