SUMMARY:

House Bill 6188 would repeal a section of the Mobile Home Commission Act that allows the Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs (LARA) to order the summary suspense of a licensee's license if LARA finds that the health, safety, or welfare requires emergency action.
