SUMMARY:

House Bill 6200 would amend the Social Welfare Act to require the Department of Human Services (DHHS) to provide notice to the legislature on a quarterly basis of any emergency order issued for the summary suspension of payments on pending or subsequent claims under the Medicaid program or for the summary suspension of a provider from that program.

MCL 400.111f

FISCAL IMPACT:

House Bill 6200 would have a negligible fiscal impact on the state to compile a quarterly notice to the legislature and no fiscal impact on local units of government.
