SUMMARY:

House Bill 6206 would amend 1982 PA 191, which authorizes the governor to declare a state of energy emergency and to issue an emergency order, proclamation, or directive with the force of law to respond to the emergency. The act now requires the governor to notify the legislature after issuing an executive order, proclamation, or directive under the act. The bill would require that this notice be made within 24 hours after the executive order, proclamation, or directive is issued.
