CONTENT

<u>House Bill 4562 (S-1)</u> would amend the Corrections Code to allow the Parole Board to conduct a subsequent parole review of prisoners who had been denied parole within five years after denying a prisoner parole under certain circumstances, and to modify certain reporting requirements.

<u>House Bill 4563</u> would amend the Corrections Code to specify that all decisions and recommendations of the Parole Board would have to be by a majority vote of the Board or, *except as otherwise prohibited by the Code*, a Parole Board panel created under the Code.

The bills are tie-barred.
