7 PROVISIONS CONCERNING APPROPRIATIONS

GENERAL SECTIONS

Sec. 201. Pursuant to section 30 of article IX of the state constitution of 1963, total state spending from state sources under part 1 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2021 is \$0.00 and total state spending from state sources to be paid to local units of government is \$0.00.

Sec. 202. The appropriations made and expenditures authorized under this part and part 1 and the departments, commissions, boards, offices, and programs for which appropriations are made under this part and part 1 are subject to the management and budget act, 1984 PA 431, MCL 18.1101 to 18.1594.

Sec. 203. If the state administrative board, acting under section 3 of 1921 PA 2, MCL 17.3, transfers funds from an amount appropriated under this act, the legislature may, by a concurrent resolution adopted by a majority of the members elected to and serving in each house, inter-transfer funds within this act for the particular department, board, commission, office, or institution.

DEPARTMENT OF MILITARY AND VETERANS AFFAIRS

Sec. 301. From the funds appropriated in part 1 for National Guard operations, the department shall, if all donated funds intended specifically for this purpose are received within 14 days

of the effective date of this act, issue a 1-time grant to eligible 1 2 soldiers who deployed to Washington, D.C. in support of the Capitol 3 Response II mission at the United States Capitol within 45 days of receiving the donated funds. In determining the amount of the grant 4 each eligible soldier is to receive, the department shall divide 5 the total amount donated, up to \$110,000.00, by the number of 6 7 eligible soldiers who deployed in order to establish an equal grant 8 amount for each soldier.
