Sec. 109n. (1) If the initial evaluation was completed by a qualified licensed practitioner, a child with a confirmed diagnosis of autism spectrum disorder is not required to have a re-evaluation to determine continued eligibility for behavioral health treatment unless a re-evaluation is medically necessary.
```

- 3 (a) A physician with a specialty in psychiatry or neurology.
- 4 (b) A physician with a subspecialty in developmental

- 7 (c) A physician with a specialty in pediatrics or other 8 appropriate specialty with training, experience, or expertise in 9 autism spectrum disorder or behavioral health.
- 10 (d) A psychologist with a specialty in clinical child
  11 psychology, behavioral and cognitive psychology, or clinical
  12 neuropsychology, or other appropriate specialty with training,
