## HOUSE SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 4117

A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled "Michigan vehicle code,"

by amending section 226 (MCL 257.226), as amended by 2021 PA 71.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 226. (1) Except as otherwise provided in subsection (13)
- 2 or (14), a vehicle registration issued by the secretary of state
- 3 expires on the owner's birthday, unless another expiration date is
- 4 provided for under this act or unless the registration is for the
- 5 following vehicles, in which case registration expires on the last
- 6 day of February:
- 7 (a) A commercial vehicle except for a commercial vehicle
- 8 issued a registration under the international registration plan or

- 1 a pickup truck or van owned by an individual.
- 2 (b) Except for a trailer or semitrailer issued a registration
- 3 under the international registration plan, a trailer or semitrailer
- 4 owned by a business, corporation, or person other than an
- 5 individual; or a pole trailer.
- 6 (2) Except as otherwise provided in subsection (13) or (14),
- 7 the expiration date for a registration issued for a motorcycle is
- 8 the motorcycle owner's birthday.
- **9** (3) The expiration date for a registration bearing the letters
- 10 "SEN" or "REP" is February 1.
- 11 (4) In the case of a vehicle owned by a business, corporation,
- 12 or an owner other than an individual, the secretary of state may
- 13 assign or reassign the expiration date of the registration.
- 14 (5) The secretary of state shall do all of the following:
- 15 (a) After the October 1 immediately preceding the year
- 16 designated on the registration, issue a registration upon
- 17 application and payment of the proper fee for a commercial vehicle,
- 18 other than a pickup or van owned by an individual; or a trailer
- 19 owned by a business, corporation, or person other than an
- 20 individual.
- 21 (b) Beginning 60 days before the expiration date assigned on
- 22 an international registration plan registration plate, issue a
- 23 registration under section 801g upon application and payment of the
- 24 proper apportioned fee for a commercial vehicle engaged in
- 25 interstate commerce.
- 26 (c) Beginning 45 days before the owner's birthday or, if the
- 27 owner has requested the expiration date described in subsection
- 28 (14), 45 days before the expiration date, and 120 days before the
- 29 expiration date assigned by the secretary of state, issue a

- 1 registration for a vehicle other than those designated in
- 2 subsection (1)(a) or (b). However, if an owner whose registration
- 3 period begins 45 days before his or her birthday or expiration date
- 4 will be out of the state during the 45 days immediately preceding
- 5 expiration of a registration or for other good cause shown cannot
- 6 apply for a renewal registration within the 45-day period,
- 7 application for a renewal registration may be made not more than 6
- 8 months before expiration.
- 9 (6) Except as otherwise provided in this subsection and
- 10 subsection (14), the secretary of state, upon application and
- 11 payment of the proper fee, shall issue a registration for a vehicle
- 12 or a motorcycle to a resident that expires on the owner's birthday
- 13 or, if applicable, on the expiration date described in subsection
- 14 (14). If the owner's next birthday is at least 6 months but not
- 15 more than 12 months in the future, the owner shall receive a
- 16 registration valid until the owner's next birthday or, if
- 17 applicable, the expiration date described in subsection (14). If
- 18 the owner's next birthday is less than 6 months in the future, the
- 19 owner shall receive a registration valid until the owner's birthday
- 20 following the owner's next birthday or, if applicable, the
- 21 expiration date described in subsection (14). The tax required
- 22 under this act for a registration described in this subsection is
- 23 either of the following:
- 24 (a) For an original registration, the tax must bear the same
- 25 relationship to the tax required under section 801 for a 12-month
- 26 registration as the length of the registration bears to 12 months.
- (b) For a renewal of a registration, either of the following:
- (i) For a registration that is for at least 6 months but not
- 29 more than 12 months, the same amount as for 12 months.

- 1 (ii) For a renewal of a registration that is for more than 12 months, 2 times the amount for 12 months.
- 3 Partial months must be considered as whole months in the
- 4 calculation of the required tax and in the determination of the
- 5 length of time between the application for a registration and the
- 6 owner's next birthday or, if applicable, the expiration date
- 7 described in subsection (14). The tax required for that
- 8 registration must be rounded off to whole dollars as provided in
- **9** section 801.
- 10 (7) A certificate of title remains valid until canceled by the
- 11 secretary of state for cause or upon a transfer of an interest
- 12 shown on the certificate of title.
- 13 (8) The secretary of state, upon request, shall issue special
- 14 registration for commercial vehicles, valid for 6 months after the
- 15 date of issue, if the full registration fee exceeds \$50.00, on the
- 16 payment of 1/2 the full registration fee and a service charge as
- 17 enumerated in section 802(1).
- 18 (9) The secretary of state may issue a special registration
- 19 for each of the following:
- 20 (a) A new vehicle purchased or leased outside of this state
- 21 and delivered in this state to the purchaser or lessee by the
- 22 manufacturer of that vehicle for removal to a place outside of this
- 23 state, if a certification is made that the vehicle will be
- 24 primarily used, stored, and registered outside of this state and
- 25 will not be returned to this state by the purchaser or lessee for
- 26 use or storage.
- 27 (b) A vehicle purchased or leased in this state and delivered
- 28 to the purchaser or lessee by a dealer or by the owner of the
- 29 vehicle for removal to a place outside of this state, if a

- 1 certification is made that the vehicle will be primarily used,
- 2 stored, and registered outside of this state and will not be
- 3 returned to this state by the purchaser or lessee for use or
- 4 storage.
- 5 (10) A special registration issued under subsection (9) is
- 6 valid for not more than 30 days after the date of issuance, and a
- 7 fee must be collected for each special registration as provided in
- 8 section 802(3). The special registration may be in the form
- 9 determined by the secretary of state. If a dealer makes a retail
- 10 sale or lease of a vehicle to a purchaser or lessee who is
- 11 qualified and eligible to obtain a special registration, the dealer
- 12 shall apply for the special registration for the purchaser or
- 13 lessee. If a person other than a dealer sells or leases a vehicle
- 14 to a purchaser or lessee who is qualified and eligible to obtain a
- 15 special registration, the purchaser or lessee shall appear in
- 16 person, or by a person exercising the purchaser's or lessee's power
- 17 of attorney, at an office of the secretary of state and furnish a
- 18 certification that the person is the bona fide purchaser or lessee
- 19 or that the person has granted the power of attorney, together with
- 20 other forms required for the issuance of the special registration
- 21 and provide the secretary of state with proof that the vehicle is
- 22 covered by an automobile insurance policy issued under section 3101
- 23 of the insurance code of 1956, 1956 PA 218, MCL 500.3101, or proof
- 24 that the vehicle is covered by a policy of insurance issued by an
- 25 insurer under section 3163 of the insurance code of 1956, 1956 PA
- 26 218, MCL 500.3163. The certification required in this subsection
- 27 must contain all of the following:
- 28 (a) The address of the purchaser or lessee.
- 29 (b) A statement that the vehicle is purchased or leased for

- 1 registration outside of this state.
- 2 (c) A statement that the vehicle must be primarily used,
- 3 stored, and registered outside of this state.
- 4 (d) The name of the jurisdiction in which the vehicle is to be registered.
- **6** (e) Other information requested by the secretary of state.
- 7 (11) In the case of a commercial vehicle, trailer, or
- 8 semitrailer issued a registration under the international
- 9 registration plan, the secretary of state in mutual agreement with
- 10 the owner may assign or reassign the expiration date of the
- 11 registration. However, the expiration date agreed to must be either
- 12 March 31, June 30, September 30, or December 31 or beginning on
- 13 February 19, 2019, the last day of a calendar month. Renewals
- 14 expiring on or after June 30, 2020 must be for a minimum of at
- 15 least 12 months if there is a change in the established expiration
- 16 date. Notwithstanding the provisions of this subsection, a
- 17 commercial vehicle, trailer, or semitrailer registration issued
- 18 under this subsection that expires on or after March 1, 2020 is
- 19 valid until March 31, 2021. Notwithstanding the provisions of this
- 20 subsection, a commercial vehicle, trailer, or semitrailer
- 21 registration issued under this subsection that expires after March
- 22 31, 2021 but before August 1, 2021 is valid until 120 days after
- 23 the date of the expiration.
- 24 (12) The expiration date for a multiyear registration issued
- 25 for a leased vehicle must be the date the lease expires but must
- 26 not be for a period longer than 24 months.
- 27 (13) A vehicle registration described in subsection (1) or a
- 28 motorcycle registration described in subsection (2) that expires on
- 29 or after March 1, 2020 is valid until March 31, 2021. A vehicle

- 1 registration described in subsection (1) or a motorcycle
- 2 registration described in subsection (2) that expires after March
- 3 31, 2021 but before August 1, 2021 is valid until 120 days after
- 4 the date of the expiration.
- 5 (14) In the case of a vehicle owned by an individual, upon
- 6 request of that individual, a vehicle registration issued by the
- 7 secretary of state expires 2 years after the owner's birthday.
- 8 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect October
- 9 1, 2022.
- 10 Enacting section 2. This amendatory act does not take effect
- 11 unless all of the following bills of the 101st Legislature are
- 12 enacted into law:
