## SENATE SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 5089

A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled "Public health code,"

by amending section 21911 (MCL 333.21911), as added by 2017 PA 172.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 21911. (1) The department may shall grant registration as
- 2 a nurse aide to an applicant who meets all of the following
- 3 requirements:
- 4 (a) Submits an application on a form and in a manner
- 5 prescribed by the department.
- 6 (b) Pays the fee prescribed in section 21919.
- 7 (c) Demonstrates Subject to subsection (4), demonstrates to
- 8 the department that he or she has successfully completed a met both
- 9 of the following:

- 1 (i) Successfully completed a nurse aide training program and a
  2 competency examination approved by the department.approved by the
  3 department.
- 4 (ii) Is competent as demonstrated by successful completion of a 5 nurse aide competency examination approved by the department.
- 6 (d) Meets the requirements for registration in rules7 promulgated under section 21923.
- 8 (2) The department may shall grant a permit as a nurse aide
  9 trainer to an applicant who meets all of the following
  10 requirements:
- (a) Submits an application on a form and in a mannerprescribed by the department.
- 13 (b) Pays the fee prescribed in section 21919.
- 14 (c) Is a registered professional nurse licensed under article
  15 15 who meets the requirements of 42 CFR 483.152(a)(5)(i) and (ii),
  16 or who meets the requirements for a permit in rules promulgated
  17 under section 21923.
- 18 (3) The department may shall grant a permit as a nurse aide 19 training program to an applicant that meets all of the following 20 requirements:
- (a) Submits an application on a form and in a mannerprescribed by the department.
  - (b) Pays the fee prescribed in section 21919.
- (c) Meets the requirements for a permit in 42 CFR 483.152 andin rules promulgated under section 21923.
- (d) Demonstrates to the department that the applicant'scurriculum is consistent with other nurse aide training programs asprovided by rules promulgated by the department under this part.
- 29 (4) Except as provided under subsection (6), the department

- 1 shall allow an applicant to complete a nurse aide competency
- 2 examination online or through remote means, or at a nursing care
- 3 facility that proctors the examination under 42 CFR 483.154. The
- 4 department shall allow the testing vendor to contract with the
- 5 staff of the nursing care facility to proctor a nurse aide
- 6 competency examination as provided under 42 CFR 483.154.
- 7 (5) Subject to subsection (6), the department shall not deny a
- 8 person a permit under subsection (3) solely because the nurse aide
- 9 training program allows individuals to complete curricula online or
- 10 through remote means, or counts the time an individual has worked
- 11 performing skills necessary of a nurse aide as time in training.
- 12 (6) The online option described under subsections (4) and (5)
- does not apply to training required under 42 CFR 483.152(a)(3) or
- 14 to testing required under 42 CFR 483.154(b)(2).
- 15 (7) (4)—A registration or permit is not transferable. A
- 16 certificate of registration or certificate of permit must state the
- 17 persons to which it applies.
