## **HOUSE BILL NO. 5977**

March 24, 2022, Introduced by Reps. Green, Whiteford, Wakeman, Brann, Kahle, Brenda Carter, Young, Pohutsky, Tyrone Carter, O'Malley and Anthony and referred to the Committee on Families, Children, and Seniors.

A bill to amend 1973 PA 116, entitled

"An act to provide for the protection of children through the licensing and regulation of child care organizations; to provide for the establishment of standards of care for child care organizations; to prescribe powers and duties of certain departments of this state and adoption facilitators; to provide penalties; and to repeal acts and parts of acts,"

(MCL 722.111 to 722.128) by adding section 6a.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 6a. (1) Beginning January 1, 2023, and every January 1

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- 1 after that, the department must conduct a comprehensive needs
- 2 assessment regarding utilizing residential treatment and the needs
- 3 of youth who are referred to this type of treatment. The assessment
- 4 must identify the types of beds currently being utilized and the
- 5 types of beds needed, the age group, gender, and geographic region
- 6 of youth receiving these treatment services and those in need of
- 7 the treatment services.
- 8 (2) As the department identifies needs of foster youth through
- 9 the assessment required in subsection (1), the department must work
- 10 with community partners to assist providers in meeting the
- 11 identified needs of the foster youth.
