- 5 (a) Refuse to transplant an organ in the individual.

- (b) Deny the individual evaluation, referral, surgery,
 counseling, or postoperative treatment for an organ transplant
- 2 counseling, or postoperative treatment for an organ transplant.
- 3 (c) Refuse to place the individual on an organ transplant
- 4 waiting list or lower the individual's priority on that waiting
- 5 list to receive an organ transplant.
- 6 (2) As used in this section:
- 7 (a) "Disability" means that term as defined in 42 USC 12102.
- 8 (b) "Organ" means that term as defined in section 10102.
