## SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 5560

A bill to amend 1927 PA 175, entitled
"The code of criminal procedure,"

(MCL 760.1 to 777.69) by adding section 21b to chapter XVI.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 21b. (1) A police officer or a prosecuting attorney may provide a domestic or sexual violence service provider agency with the name, demographics, and other pertinent information of, and information to facilitate contact with a victim of domestic or sexual violence for the purpose of offering supportive services to the victim. If a police officer or prosecuting attorney provides information to a domestic or sexual violence service provider agency under this section, that police officer or prosecuting

- 18 means an agency that receives funding from the department of health
- 19 and human services division of victim services to provide
- 20 confidential supportive services to victims of domestic or sexual
- 21 violence, receives a federal grant through the United States
- 22 Department of Justice to provide confidential supportive services
- 23 to victims of domestic or sexual violence, or is associated with an
- 24 Indian tribe and is providing confidential supportive services to
- 25 victims of domestic or sexual violence.
