- Sec. 20. (1) A school bus may be equipped with a stop-arm camera system in accordance with this section.

- 1 (b) Enter into a contract with a private vendor to install and 2 operate a stop-arm camera system on a school bus.
- 3 (3) As used in this section, "stop-arm camera system" means a 4 system of 2 or more cameras affixed to a school bus that meets all 5 of the following requirements:
- 6 (a) Is synchronized to automatically record video or 1 or more
 7 sequenced photographs of a vehicle failing to stop for a school bus
 8 or passing a school bus in violation of section 682(1) of the
 9 Michigan vehicle code, 1949 PA 300, MCL 257.682.
- 10 (b) Is capable of capturing images of all of the following:
- 11 (i) The vehicle.
- 12 (\ddot{i}) The registration plate on the rear of the vehicle.
- 13 (iii) A distance of not less than 200 feet in front of the school bus.
- 15 (c) Records the date, time, and location on an image produced 16 by the system.
