## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 349. (1) To obtain the printing of the name of a person

- **6** (2) To obtain the printing of the name of a candidate of a
- 7 political party under the particular party's heading upon the
- 8 primary election ballots in the various voting precincts of the
- 9 township, there may be filed by the candidate, in lieu of filing
- 10 nominating petitions, a nonrefundable filing fee of \$100.00 to be
- 11 paid to the township clerk. Payment of the fee and certification of
- 12 the candidate's name paying the fee are governed by the same
- 13 provisions as in the case of nominating petitions. The fee must be
- 14 deposited in the general fund of the township and must be refunded
- 15 to candidates who are nominated and to an equal number of
- 16 candidates who receive the next highest number of votes in the
- 17 primary election. If 2 or more candidates tie in having the lowest
- 18 number of votes allowing a refund, the sum of \$100.00 must be
- 19 divided among them. The deposits of all other defeated candidates,
- 20 as well as the deposits of candidates who withdraw or are
- 21 disqualified, are forfeited and the candidates must be notified of
- 22 the forfeiture. Deposits forfeited under this section must be paid
- 23 into and credited to the general fund of the township.used only for
- 24 the purchase and maintenance of voting equipment.
- 25 (3) Within 4 days after the last day for filing nominating
- 26 petitions or a filing fee, the township clerk shall deliver to the
- 27 county clerk a list setting forth the name, address, and political
- 28 affiliation and office sought of each candidate who has qualified
- 29 for a position on the primary ballot.
