## **HOUSE BILL NO. 4746**

April 29, 2021, Introduced by Reps. Hauck, Hertel and Lilly and referred to the Committee on Regulatory Reform.

A bill to amend 1998 PA 58, entitled "Michigan liquor control code of 1998,"

by amending section 914b (MCL 436.1914b), as added by 2018 PA 346.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 914b. (1) Except as otherwise provided in subsection (2),
- 2 a person shall not use or offer for use, possess, sell, or offer
- 3 for sale marihuana-infused beer, wine, mixed wine drink, mixed
- 4 spirit drink, or spirits. A person that violates this section is
- 5 guilty of a misdemeanor punishable as provided in section 909.

- (2) This section does not apply to a hospital that operates primarily for the purpose of conducting scientific research, a state institution conducting bona fide research, a private college or university conducting bona fide research, or a pharmaceutical company or biotechnology company conducting bona fide research.
  - (3) As used in this section:
- (a) "Marihuana" means that term as defined in section 7106—3 of the public health code, 1978 PA 368, MCL 333.7106.Michigan Regulation and Taxation of Marihuana Act, 2018 IL 1, MCL 333.27953.
- (b) "Marihuana-infused beer, wine, mixed wine drink, mixed spirit drink, or spirits" means beer, wine, mixed wine drink, mixed spirit drink, or spirits that contain any amount of marihuana.
- Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days after the date it is enacted into law.
