SENATE SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 4762

A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled "Public health code,"

(MCL 333.1101 to 333.25211) by adding section 10251.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 10251. (1) In providing health care and other services
- 2 related to an organ transplant, a health care provider in this
- 3 state shall not discriminate against an individual who has a
- 4 disability based solely on the individual's disability.
- 5 Discriminating against an individual who has a disability based
- 6 solely on the individual's disability includes, but is not limited
- 7 to, any of the following:
- 8 (a) Refusing to transplant an organ in the individual based
- 9 solely on the individual's disability.

- 1 (b) Subject to subsection (2), refusing to transplant an organ
- 2 in the individual based on an assessment that the individual will
- 3 be unable, without support, to comply with postransplantation
- 4 medical requirements because of the individual's disability.
- 5 (c) Refusing to place the individual on an organ transplant
- 6 waiting list or lowering the individual's priority on that waiting
- 7 list to receive an organ transplant, based solely on the
- 8 individual's disability.
- 9 (d) Refusing to provide or diminish the quality of counseling
- 10 or postoperative treatment for the individual based solely on the
- 11 individual's disability.
- 12 (2) A health care provider in this state shall consider the
- 13 support of an individual described under subsection (1) in
- 14 determining the individual's ability to comply with
- 15 postransplantation medical requirements.
- 16 (3) An individual with a disability who reasonably believes
- 17 that a health care provider has violated this section may bring an
- 18 action for injunctive relief in the appropriate court. The action
- 19 for injunctive relief must be heard in an expedited manner.
- 20 (4) This section does not limit an individual's rights or
- 21 remedies otherwise provided by law.
- 22 (5) As used in this section:
- (a) "Disability" means that term as defined in 42 USC 12102.
- 24 (b) "Health care provider" means both of the following:
- 25 (i) An individual licensed, registered, or otherwise authorized
- 26 to engage in a health profession under article 15.
- 27 (ii) A health facility or agency licensed under article 17.
- 28 (c) "Organ" means that term as defined in section 10102.
