Sec. 11. (1) The director, the director's agent, or personnel

- 8 more often than annually to advise in matters affecting health or

- 13 (a) Department staff, if the facility is licensed or proposed

- with procedures established and on forms provided by the bureau of

- 3 (4) Except as provided in subsection (3) (b) and section 10(2),
 4 the inspector shall must administer and enforce the rules
 5 promulgated by the department.
- 6 (5) Upon receipt of a request from an adult foster care 7 facility for certification of a specialized program for 8 developmentally disabled or mentally ill adults, the department 9 shall must inspect the facility to determine whether the proposed 10 specialized program conforms with the requirements of applicable 11 law and rules. The department shall must provide the department of 12 health and human services with an inspection report and a 13 certification, denial of certification, or certification with 14 limited terms for the proposed specialized program. The department 15 shall must reinspect a certified specialized program not less than 16 once biennially. In carrying out this subsection, the department may contract with a county community mental health board or any 17 other agency for services. 18
- 19 (6) Inspection reports required by this section shall must be 20 furnished to the department and shall be used in the evaluation for licensing of an adult foster care facility. The department shall 21 must consider the reports carefully and may make special 22 23 consultations if necessary. The department shall be is responsible 24 for the final determination of the issuance, denial, or revocation 25 and the temporary or provisional nature of a license issued to an adult foster care facility. A report of the department's findings 26 27 shall must be furnished to the licensee or applicant.
- 28 (7) The inspection reports required by this section shall be
 29 available for public inspection during reasonable business hours.

(8) The department shall submit biannual reports to the 1 2 appropriation subcommittees for the department, the senate and house fiscal agencies, and the state budget director containing a 3 summary of input from individuals who perform inspections for 4 5 entities regulated by the bureau of community and health systems, 6 or a successor agency within the department. The feedback and input 7 must be regarding the adequacy of federal and state guidelines 8 pertaining to the areas that the individual inspects for the 9 entities described in this section. The summary must include 10 details of the feedback excluding information that identifies the 11 inspectors providing the feedback. The summary may be cumulative in nature, but must be understandable to the general public. 12
