## **HOUSE BILL NO. 5696**

January 26, 2022, Introduced by Reps. Young and Wendzel and referred to the Committee on Regulatory Reform.

A bill to amend 1998 PA 58, entitled "Michigan liquor control code of 1998,"

by amending section 502 (MCL 436.1502), as amended by 2020 PA 112.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 502. (1) Subject to subsection (3), the commission shall
- 2 issue a salesperson license to an individual who is a designated
- 3 employee of any of the following persons:
- 4 (a) A manufacturer of beer.
- 5 (b) A manufacturer of wine.
- 6 (c) A manufacturer of mixed spirit drink.

- 1 (d) An outstate seller of beer.
- 2 (e) An outstate seller of wine.
- 3 (f) An outstate seller of mixed spirit drink.
- 4 (q) A wholesaler.
- 5 (h) A broker that represents 1 or more persons described in
- 6 subdivisions (a) to (g).
- 7 (i) A broker described in subdivision (h) that also represents
- 8 1 or more of the following persons:
- 9 (i) A vendor of spirits.
- 10 (ii) A manufacturer of spirits.
- 11 (j) A vendor of spirits.
- 12 (k) A manufacturer of spirits.
- 13 (l) A broker that represents only 1 or more of the following:
- 14 (i) A vendor of spirits.
- 15 (ii) A manufacturer of spirits.
- 16 (2) A salesperson license issued under this section after
- 17 April 15, 2018 but before April 30, 2020 expires on April 30, 2020.
- 18 A salesperson license issued under this section is renewable every
- 19 3 years with the first triennial renewal cycle beginning May 1,
- 20 2020. The commission may charge a reasonable initial license fee
- 21 and triennial renewal fee. The commission shall establish a fee
- 22 under this section by written order. The nonrefundable inspection
- 23 fee under section 529(4) is not required for an application for a
- 24 new salesperson license or transfer of a salesperson license. A
- 25 salesperson license issued or renewed under R 436.1853 of the
- 26 Michigan Administrative Code expires on the earlier of the
- 27 following dates:
- 28 (a) Three years after the date of the issuance or renewal.
- 29 (b) April 30, 2020.

- (3) The commission shall not impose any other requirement or 1 2 consider any other factor beyond the accreditation required in this section for issuance or renewal of a salesperson license. Except as 3 otherwise provided in this subsection, the commission shall not 4 5 issue a salesperson license under this section unless the applicant 6 submits with his or her application written documentation that the 7 applicant has successfully completed a salesperson accreditation 8 program. Except as otherwise provided in this subsection, the 9 commission shall not renew a salesperson license issued under this 10 section or under R 436.1853 of the Michigan Administrative Code 11 unless the licensee submits with his or her application proof 12 acceptable to the commission that the licensee has successfully completed a salesperson accreditation program no more than 120 days 13 14 before the date the licensee submits his or her renewal 15 application. An applicant's completion of a salesperson 16 accreditation program is not a condition for issuance or renewal of

a salesperson license for any of the following applicants:

19 (b) A designated employee of a vendor of spirits.

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- 20 (c) A designated employee of a broker described in subsection 21 (1)(l).
- 22 (4) Except as provided in subsection (5), an individual shall 23 not sell, deliver, promote, or otherwise assist in the sale of 24 alcoholic liquor in any manner to a retailer in this state unless 25 licensed under this section or under R 436.1853 of the Michigan 26 Administrative Code. An individual licensed as a salesperson under 27 R 436.1853 of the Michigan Administrative Code before April 15, 28 2018 shall comply with the requirements of this section on renewal of his or her salesperson license, application for a subsequent 29

- salesperson license under a different employer, or a request totransfer his or her salesperson license to a different employer.
- 3 (5) This section does not require an individual who is at
- 4 least 18-16 years of age and who only does any of the following to
- 5 be licensed as a salesperson:
- 6 (a) Builds a display of those brands that are represented or7 sold by the individual's employer for an off-premises retailer.
- 8 (b) Marks the price on those brands that are represented or9 sold by the individual's employer for an off-premises retailer.
- 10 (c) Rotates brands that are represented or sold by the
  11 individual's employer for an off-premises retailer.
- (d) Places brands that are represented or sold by theindividual's employer on shelves for an off-premises retailer.
- (e) For an individual who holds a Michigan commercial driver license or chauffeur's license, transports, in a vehicle licensed by the commission under section 525, and delivers alcoholic liquor to a retailer.
- 18 (6) The commission shall approve a salesperson license
  19 accreditation program designed for salesperson licensees if the
  20 commission determines that the program's curriculum includes an

- 3 (i) Product adjustments as provided for in this act.
- $\mathbf{4}$  (7) A person described in subsection (1)(a) to (g) or a
- 5 qualified trade association may apply to the commission for
- 6 qualification as an administrator for the offering of a salesperson
- 7 accreditation program.
- **8** (8) On approval of a salesperson accreditation program under
- 9 subsection (6), the commission shall appoint the person or
- 10 qualified trade association sponsoring the salesperson
- 11 accreditation program as administrator of that program.
- 12 (9) As used in this section:
- 13 (a) "Administrator" means a person described in subsection
- 14 (1)(a) to (g) or a qualified trade association authorized by the
- 15 commission to offer salesperson accreditation programs.
- 16 (b) "Broker" means that term as defined in R 436.1001 of the
- 17 Michigan Administrative Code.
- 18 (c) "Designated employee" means an individual who sells,
- 19 delivers, promotes, or otherwise assists in the sale of alcoholic
- 20 liquor.
- 21 (d) "Qualified trade association" means a trade association
- 22 that represents a person described in subsection (1)(a) to (q) that
- 23 employs individuals to act as salespersons.
- 24 (e) "Salesperson accreditation program" means a program that
- 25 the commission approves under subsection (6) and that is offered by
- 26 an administrator.
