THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 8507a. (1) To facilitate continued access to markets for
- 2 fertilizer, the department may do 1 or both of the following:
- 3 (a) At the request of a licensee or based upon records
- 4 voluntarily supplied by a licensee, inspect, audit, or certify
- 5 locations where fertilizer is manufactured in this state.

- (b) Issue certificates of free sale under subsection (3).
- 2 (2) A licensee shall submit an application for a certificate
- 3 of free sale on a form and in a manner prescribed by the
- 4 department.
- 5 (3) The department shall grant or deny an application for a
- 6 certificate of free sale within 10 business days after the
- 7 department receives a completed application under subsection (2)
- 8 and the application fee under subsection (4). If the department
- 9 determines that the application meets the requirements of this part
- 10 and the rules promulgated under this part, the department shall
- 11 issue a certificate of free sale. If the department determines that

- 24 (7) As used in this section, "certificate of free sale" means
- 25 a document that is issued by the department that verifies that the
- 26 fertilizer listed is manufactured in this state and is legally sold
- 27 or distributed in this state and on the open market with the
- 28 approval of the department.
