## **SENATE BILL NO. 60**

January 28, 2021, Introduced by Senator VICTORY and referred to the Committee on Regulatory Reform

A bill to amend 2016 PA 407, entitled "Skilled trades regulation act," by amending section 807 (MCL 339.5807).

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 807. (1) An applicant is not eligible for a work
- 2 classification examination under this article unless the applicant
- 3 meets the requirements under provided in article 2, is of good
- 4 moral character, and has meets 1 or more of the following:

2 (5) If an applicant provides evidence satisfactory to the 3 department that he or she has successfully completed a 2-year, or 4 equivalent, HVAC program provided by a recognized trade school, community college, or university, or a 2-year HVAC training program 5 6 approved by the United States Department of Labor, the department 7 shall credit the completion of that program toward the 3 years or 8 6,000 hours of work experience required under subsection (1)(a). 9 The amount credited, as determined by the department, shall not 10 exceed 1 year or 2,000 hours of the 3 years or 6,000 hours
