SENATE BILL NO. 257

March 18, 2021, Introduced by Senator MACDONALD and referred to the Committee on Government Operations.

A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled "Public health code,"

by amending sections 2253 and 2453 (MCL 333.2253 and 333.2453), section 2253 as amended by 2006 PA 157.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 2253. (1) If Except as otherwise provided in subsection
- 2 (4), if the director determines that control of an epidemic is
- 3 necessary to protect the public health, the director by emergency
- 4 order may prohibit the gathering of people for any purpose and may

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- 1 establish procedures to be followed during the epidemic to insure
- 2 ensure continuation of essential public health services and
- 3 enforcement of health laws. Emergency procedures shall are not be
- 4 limited to this code.
- 5 (2) If an epidemic described in subsection (1) involves avian
- 6 influenza or another virus or disease that is or may be spread by
- 7 contact with animals, the department of agriculture and rural
- 8 development shall cooperate with and assist the director in the
- 9 director's response to the epidemic.
- 10 (3) Upon On request from the director, the department of
- 11 agriculture and rural development shall assist the department in
- 12 any review or update of the department's pandemic influenza plan
- 13 under section 5112.
- 14 (4) The director shall not issue an emergency order under this

- 10 (iii) A sporting event recognized by a local organization that 11 is engaged in the development and active promotion of an athletic 12 activity.
- 13 (e) "School" means a public school or nonpublic school as
 14 those terms are defined in section 5 of the revised school code,
 15 1976 PA 451, MCL 380.5.

- 18 epidemic is necessary to protect the public health, the local
- 19 health officer may issue an emergency order to prohibit the

- 21 be followed by persons, including a local governmental entity,
- 22 during the epidemic to insure ensure continuation of essential
- 23 public health services and enforcement of health laws. Emergency
